





Type 2 (IEC 62196-2) plug with cable or socket without cable












# Step 1

The distance between mounting panel and bottom needs to be more than 1.2 meters and more than 0.5 meters between the panel and side of wall

Punching: Drill 6 holes on the board as image




# Step 2

### Installation:

Insert bolts to the holes and plugged

### Fixing:

Align the panel to the 6 holes accurately



# Step 3

## Fixing:

Align the side hole of EV charger to the panel's side holes

Installation: Plug the EV charger with 4 M6\*8 bolts



# Setp 4

### Connect power cord:

PS:All electrical wiring must be done by a qualified electrician and comply with all local codes and regulations. (Figure 1)

Open the cover and connect the cord to the connection terminal in accordance with figure 2
